# SEASON NOTES

**Hometown Heroines:** The Bulldogs are an undefeated 7-0 when playing at home in Athens this season. Only counting regular season matches (the Bulldogs hosted the 2014 NCAA Championships and lost to Florida in the quarterfinals), Georgia has not lost at the Dan Magill Tennis Complex since April 11, 2014 (Alabama) and is on an 8-0 run.

## **Herring Chasing History:**

• Senior Lauren Herring has 106 career doubles victories, which ties her for fifth (Chelsey Gullickson) in the Georgia record books. Kate Fuller owns the all-time record with 123 doubles victories.

• Herring currently has 113 singles wins and needs to reach the 123-win mark to move into the top-10 in Georgia career singles victories.

• Herring has 219 combined wins, placing her in the top-10 (T-7) for career combined singles/doubles wins in Georgia women's tennis history. With two more wins she will break into the top-5. Maho Kowase holds the record with 245 combined career wins.

**Freshman of the Week:** Freshman Ellen Perez was named SEC Freshman of the Week on Feb. 25 after going undefeated in singles and doubles against Georgia Tech. She also stunned the crowd with a rare, behind-the-back volley that landed for a winner.

**Terrific Tandem:** Caroline Brinson and Hannah King received SEC Player of the Week and SEC Freshman of the Week honors, respectively, on Feb. 11 after their impressive performances at the ITA National Team Indoor Championships. Both were also named to the all-tournament team.

**Fabulous Finalists:** Georgia appeared in its seventh ITA National Team Indoor Championships title match in February, losing 4-1 to No. 3 UNC. The run-in to the final was remarkable, as the team knocked off No. 15 Michigan, No. 1 UCLA, and No. 5 California to deservedly book their place in the final two. The Bulldogs are 3-4 all-time in the indoor final, having last won in 2002 against Vanderbilt.

**Top Dawgs:** With their 4-2 victory over UCLA at the 2015 ITA Indoors in Charlottesville, the Bulldogs knocked off the nation's No. 1 ranked team for the first time since 2008 (Georgia Tech).

**King of Clutch:** Freshman Hannah King recorded back-to-back match clinchers against No. 1 UCLA and No. 5 California at the ITA Indoors while playing in the number five spot.

**Dawg on Top:** No. 19 Lauren Herring defeated the nation's top-ranked singles player when she beat UVA's Julia Elbaba 7-5, 6-4 on Feb. 2 in Charlottes-ville.

**Back-to-Back SEC Player of the Week:** Lauren Herring earned back-to-back SEC Player of the Week honors on Jan. 28 and Feb. 4. The senior was 4-0 in singles and 3-0 in doubles during the two-week span.

**Kicking-Off:** The UGA women's tennis team served as a host site for the 2015 ITA Kick-Off weekend and won both of its matches (Samford and Auburn) to progress to the ITA National Team Indoor Championships hosted by Virginia from Feb. 6-9.

**Preseason Predictions:** Jeff Wallace and the other SEC women's tennis coaches voted in an SEC preseason rankings poll just before the start of the 2015 season. Georgia was predicted to finish the regular season No. 2 behind Florida.

A Look Back at Georgia's NCAA Titles: The Georgia women's tennis team has won five grand slam titles, including the NCAA championships in 1994 and 2000. 2014 marked the 20-year anniversary of the Bulldogs' first national title, which was also the first time the women's championships were held in the Classic City. In 2000, the Bulldogs traveled to Malibu, Calif. where they beat South Alabama, Southern California,

Florida and Stanford. Georgia's win snapped the Cardinal's 48-match winning streak.

Best College (Tennis) Town in America: Athens, Ga., is widely considered one of the best, if not the best, college towns in America, but its identity as a college tennis town shouldn't be overlooked. Largely due to the influence of legendary coach Dan Magill, Athens has played host to the NCAA Round of 16 and beyond 31 total times, with the women's tournament occuring in Athens seven times, three of which occured before the men's and women's championships were combined (1994, 2004, 2005, 2007, 2010, 2012 and 2014).

Best Fans in the Country: Georgia took home the title in the 2014 Intercollegiate Tennis Association's (ITA) Attendance Race.

Georgia led the nation with 4,747 fans coming to watch the Bulldogs play last season. The Bulldogs averaged 396 fans over 12 matches, 100 more than runner-up Baylor. Athens was also the home to three of the nation's most attended matches last season (Alabama. 833; Missouri, 608; Florida, 602).

## GEORGIA HEAD COACH JEFF WALLACE

Jeff Wallace, the nation's winningest active women's tennis coach, has built Georgia into one of the elite college programs that both wins and plays host to NCAA Championships. The 2014-15 season marks his 30th year with the Bulldogs.

Last season, Wallace coached the team to the NCAA guarterfinals after winning his sixth SEC Tournament championship. For his efforts, he was awarded with ITA Southeast Region Coach of the Year honors. The team finished with a final ranking of No. 4 and a 24-5 record. In 2013, Wallace became one of three coaches in women's tennis history to reach the 600-win plateau. He is one of six active collegiate tennis coaches with at least 600 wins, and is one of five UGA coaches to reach the mark. In 2009 following another memorable campaign when Georgia advanced to its 10th NCAA Final Four, Wallace became the first person to ever be named the Intercollegiate Tennis Association National Coach of the Year four times. The 2010 season featured Chelsey Gullickson winning the NCAA singles title at the Dan Magill Tennis Complex. The past four years, Georgia has finished the year ranked in the top eight after reaching the quarterfinals of the NCAA Championships.

### **Proven Winner**

During his tenure, Wallace's squads have claimed two NCAA championships, three USTA/ITA National Team Indoor titles and eight Southeastern Conference crowns. A four-time National Coach of the Year recipient and four-time SEC Coach of the Year, Wallace's career record entering the 2015 season is 631-155. His .803 winning percentage is the best among active Division I coaches with a minimum of 500 victories.

Wallace's teams are the picture of consistency. With the 2014 NCAA bid, Georgia has appeared in 28 straight NCAA Tournaments and has advanced to the "Final Four" 10 times. Only once during his time as coach of the Bulldogs has the team missed the NCAA Tournament, and that was his first year back in 1986.

### **NCAA Champions**

The 1994 season ranks as one of the most dominant ever in women's tennis history. It found Georgia on the champion's pedestal in every major team tournament possible: NCAA Champions, USTA/ITA National Team Indoor Champions, and SEC regular season and tournament champions. Top that all off with a 27-2 overall record including a perfect 14-0 SEC mark and a season sweep of arch-rival Florida and it's easy to see why Wallace was named coach of the year.

The 2000 Bulldogs went 27-2, winning the Southeastern Conference title and the NCAA National Championship. In the title match on the campus of Pepperdine, Georgia dethroned the defending champion Stanford Cardinal 5-4, snapping a 48-match winning streak. Wallace was named the Wilson/ITA National Coach of the Year.

## **ITA National Team Indoors**

Under Wallace, the Bulldogs have been among the most successful teams at the USTA/ITA National Team Indoor Championships. The annual event attracts the nation's finest programs. The Bulldogs have won the title three times (1994, 1995, 2002) and have reached at least the semifinals 16 times.

## **Playing/Coaching Career**

A 1985 graduate of the University of Georgia, Wallace capped his playing career under legendary Bulldog head coach Dan Magill in 1984 after winning the SEC singles title at the No. 6 spot. The very next season, his first as coach of the Bulldogs, Wallace led a struggling team up the path of respectability by posting a 20-9 mark and landing a spot in the final Volvo Tennis/ITCA Top 25 poll. In 1987, just two years removed from a losing record, Georgia advanced to the national championship match. Although they didn't win it that year, the Bulldogs would have their day.

### **Success in Wallace Era**

In 25 of the past 29 seasons, Georgia has finished with a top 10 national ranking including No. 1 in 1994 and 2000. In the Wallace era, seven Bulldogs have won grand slam titles, two have won the Honda-Broderick Award/tennis, 30 Bulldogs have earned All-America honors 96 times, and 49 different Bulldogs have been listed on the SEC Academic Honor Roll.

#### Family

A native of Portland, Ore., Wallace is married to the former Sabina Marie Horne. They have two children, Brittany Sabina (25) and Jarryd Jeffrey (24). Brittany is a graduate of Valdosta State and is working in Atlanta while Jarryd is training full-time as a sprinter for the U.S. Paralympic Team. Jarryd competed in the 2012 Paralympics in London.. In November of 2011, Jarryd, a world record holder, captured a gold medal in the 100m race at the Parapan American Games in Mexico as a member of the United States Paralympic Team.

Sabina, a former All-SEC distance runner at Georgia, was inducted into the North Bay (Ontario, Canada) Sports Hall of Fame in 1996. She has continued to run competitively and has helped Wallace train for road races and marathons. Sabina is the track representative for Georgia's "G" club, an alumni association for University of Georgia letter-winners. Also, Wallace received the 2002 Distinguished Alumni Award from the Recreation and Leisure Studies department of the University of Georgia's College of Education.
